

BOOTY CAMP® PARENTAL AGREEMENT

The parent or primary caregiver must attend the class with the child. Grandparents and additional caregivers are also welcome to attend. A maximum of three adults per family allowed.

The parent or primary caregiver must ensure that there are no major plans or events for three days following the seminar, i.e., birthday parties, vacations, field trips, etc. A child with Special Needs may take up to two weeks depending on the severity (this includes holding the child out of school, activities and therapy sessions for the duration of the training).

The parent or primary caregiver must specify if the child has special needs at the time of registration.

The parent or primary caregiver must focus primarily on the child for three days following the seminar, without distractions such as, toys, television, extended phone conversations, video games, etc. Ideally the training will continue in a central area, such as the kitchen.

The parent or primary caregiver must purchase an additional potty seat for use in the car.

At bedtime, the use of Pull-Ups is acceptable. However, it is strongly recommended that a potty and plastic backed mat be placed in the child's bedroom.

Upon completion of the seminar, the parent of caregiver **MUST NOT** resume the use of diapers under any circumstances.

Parents must check in by 8:00 p.m. nightly during training.
